LADIES GOLF LEAGUE Cathy Messner noted that the dates for the spring tournament and the scramble have been changed. She will make sure Paul Ilgen gets those dates.

Cathy also restated the displeasure of the ladies league with the maintenance staff on league day. Paul feels those problems are solved but asked the ladies to report to him if the maintenance crew does not show proper etiquette.

Cathy also questioned whether a special box could be set up on the website that the league

representative could have access to that would allow them to immediately warn members of any delays in play on league day. Ed Oliver said he would talk with administration and see if that is possible.

MEN'S GOLF LEAGUE Jim Bucenell said that with the freezing temperatures we have been experiencing that the men's league will not cancel but will delay the tee times where necessary.
